Tag-Sav-R

Tag-Sav-R is a handheld tool that safely removes most two-piece livestock ear tags from the live animal without cutting near the eyes. The tool can be used to correct tagging mistakes or save both parts of the tag for re-use; especially cost saving for expensive farm name or special logo stamped tags. **Tag-Sav-R** was invented by Floyd Simpson, a farmer in Belmont County, Ohio. It is assembled and manufactured in Ohio entirely from USA material. The **Tag-Sav-R** is U.S. and foreign patented and marketed domestically and internationally by NASCO catalog sales.
